14 Sauvignon Blanc, Vidal Estate Marlborough, New Zealand Classically crisp and herbaceously intense with great complexity, a mingling of passion-fruit and melon flavours.	£9	£12	£36
15 Soave Classico, Bolla, Italy Bouquet of apricot and pepper, dry yet with soft acidity and a creamy almond palate, a blending of the highly prized Trebbiano di Soave grape.			£29
16 Picpoul de Pinet, Réserve Mirou, France Citrusy southern French white made from the Picpoul grape.			£30
17 Rioja Blanco, Don Jacobo, Bodegas Corral, Spain Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape.			£30
18 Flagstone Word of Mouth Viognier, Western Cape, South Africa Lovely aromatic, ripe watermelon, juicy peaches sprinkled with spice - a deliciously fruity cool-climate South African white.			£32
19 Lolo Albariño, Rías Baixas, Paco y Lola, Spain Notes of zippy, green apple and lemon peel with a hint of white-fleshed plum.			£35
20 Soellner Roter Veltliner von Gösing, Wagram, Austria The Roter Veltliner grape, native to Austria, has earned little attention in the past but is now becoming a star with cult potential. Dry with lively notes of fresh yellow plum and mandarin open up into a friendly, fresh palate that combines rich fruit and zingy citrus.			£36
21 The Federalist Chardonnay, Mendocino County, USA Rich fruit, reminiscent of lemon curd and pear on the nose; the palate has a lush texture and long, smooth finish punctuated with cinnamon and cardamom spice.			£40
22 St Hallet Riesling, Eden Valley, Australia Forget what you know about Riesling with its varying sweetness levels and confusing labels! This Aussie example is firmly dry with vibrant citrus fruits. Fresh and crisp with a steely minerality and note of ripe apples, limes and honey with some spice.			£42
23 Sancerre, La Fuzelle, Adrian Maréchal, France Distinctively elegant. Laden with racy crispness and abundant gooseberry crunch.			£45
24 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand Layers of pure striking flavours combining the distinctive grassy aromas and surprising redcurrant spiciness and fresh lemon zest.			£50
25 Pouilly-Fuisse, Les Ancolies, Jean Loron, France A steely, dry yet rich white Burgundy from this most prestigious of the Mâconnais vineyards. It combines honeyed peachy richness with a citrus freshness.			£55

29 Cabernet Sauvignon, Between Thorns, Australia A medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon, showing blackcurrant and fruits of the forest backed by notes of chocolate and vanilla on the finish.	£6	£8	£24
30 Merlot, Santa Rita 8KM, Chile Plums and blackberries dominate this wine, with subtle spicy and vanilla notes that come from the interaction with French and American oak.	£6	£8	£24
31 Malbec, Rare Vineyards , Pays D'Oc, France Having achieved fame in Argentina, Malbec returns home. Lovely violet aromas, solid fruit flavours and a splash of spiced oak.	£7	£9	£26
32 Shiraz, The Manor, Nederburg, South Africa An abundance of prunes and oak-spice aromas; met on the palate by flavours of ripe plums and cherries.	£8	£10	£29
33 Pinot Noir, Dashwood, New Zealand Cherry, hints of chocolate and spice; dark fruits follow on the palate entwined with pepper spice and a savoury finish with soft tannins.	£9	£12	£36
34 Carmenere Errazuriz, Aconcagua Valley, Chile Ripe red and black fruits with slightly spicy vanilla finish from spending 3 months in oak.			£29
35 Cote De Rhone, Gentilhomme Ogier, France This specialist House creates a distinctive fuller-bodied berry style with mellow spiciness from time in oak barrels.			£29
36 Merlot, Passori Rosso, Italy A baby Amarone! Made with grapes that are left to dry on the vine to concentrate richness and complexity in the wine. Rich and smooth showing plum and dried fruit followed by notes of spice and vanilla.			£32
37 Valpolicella Classico, Bolla, Veneto, Italy Light to medium-bodied in style with soft tannins. This wine has a fresh aroma of cherries, red currants and blackberries, with a hint of black pepper and walnuts.			£34
38 Altos Ibéricos, Rioja Crianza, Torres, Spain The nose reveals ripened black fruits and aromas of cocoa and nutmeg, the silky palate combines creamy blackberry with spicy oak notes.			£34
39 Altos de José Ignacio Tannat-Merlot, Uruguay Tannat is a grape originally from France, where it can be quite austere. However this wine from the warm climate of Uruguay is smooth, fruity and juicy. Grown in vineyards close to the South Atlantic Ocean, this is Merlot with a twist! Aromas of ripe blackberries and redcurrants.			£34
40 Fleurie Pascal Clement, France The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.			£35
41 Gamay Pinot Noir, Chateaux Bourguignons Rouge, Louis Jadot, France A blend of Pinot Noir from Burgundy and Gamay from Beaujolais, fresh and light on the palate with red and black summer fruits.			£36
42 St Hallett Faith Shiraz, Barossa, Australia From the Famous Barossa valley, this wine shows notes of dark cherries and hints of chocolate entwined with pepper spice.			£38
43 Vistalba Corte C Malbec, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina A top quality Malbec from specially-selected vineyards in Mendoza, blended with Cabernet Sauvignon for structure and native Bonarda for freshness. Shows red fruits, prunes and cherry flavours, with silky tannins on a full-bodied finish.			£38
44 The Federalist Cabernet Sauvignon, Lodi, USA Aromas of blackberry and blueberry with notes of cinnamon spice; the palate has a firm structure and a long, smooth finish.			£45
45 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Bartavelles, Jean Luc Colombo, France On the nose a powerful wine, full, complete and silky with notes of ripe fruit, liquorice and gingerbread. The palate is elegant, rich and deep with mature and velvety tannins.			£60
46 Serafino Barolo, Italy One of the great red wines of Italy, Nebbiolo grapes offer powerful aromas of violets and black cherries enveloped in powerful richness.			£65
47 Brunello Di Montalcino Villa Poggio Salvi, Italy Powerful and intense remarkable red from Montalcino in Tuscany. Rich fruit, cinnamon and tobacco aromas mingle with harmonic soft fruit, vanilla oak and spice.			£65
48 Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Bolla, Veneto, Italy The traditional method of semi-drying the grapes first ensures an enveloping, velvet richness with marzipan, raisin and date flavours.			£70
