RIPE & JUICY

Catarratto, Unfiltered Cielo, Sicily, Italy, 2015 <i>Delicious Catarratto from beautiful Sicily. Certified organic grapes and winery, minimal intervention throughout. No fining agents and no filtration are used. As a result some bottles show a small amount of very fine lees sediment in the bottom of the bottle, but with this comes the benefit of greater flavour, texture and mouthfeel to the wine, rather than being stripped bare as you will find with more commercially made white wines.</i>	22.00 7.50 5.20
Sauvignon Blanc, The Long White Marlborough, New Zealand, 2016 <i>Pale in colour with nettle on the nose and gooseberry, passionate fruit and kiwi on the palate. Intensely fresh with good balance and a lime finish.</i>	24.00
Laxas Albariño Galicia, Spain, 2015 <i>A clear, brilliant wine with aromas of green fruit and stone fruit and light floral notes.</i>	24.00

LIGHT & DELICATE

Santenay, 1er Cru, Domaine Debray Côte d'Or, France, 2010

45.00

Vivid ruby wine with a kirsch and forest floor nose and a bright palate. Minimal oak with silky tannins and boundless persistence.

Nuits St George, Domaine Pierre Andre Burgundy, France, 2010

76.00

Excellent example of this rich warming wine, epitomising the best of Cote de Nuits. Rich, full pinot nose and elegant red fruit.

Pinot Nero, Rechsteiner Veneto, Italy, 2013

23.00 | 7.50 | 5.25

Light cherry, raspberry and blackberry aromas combine to form a pretty, fruity palate on this pinot noir equivalent. Light and dry with a tannic backbone.

Pinot Noir, All That Jazz Marlborough, New Zealand, 2011

36.00

This is a soft, mellow Pinot Noir with savoury dark red berry and herb flavours.

RIPE & JUICY

Merlot, Pacifico Sur Valley Central, Chile, 2016

19.00 | 6.40 | 4.45

Estate grown and bottled in the heart of the Curico Valley. Ripe blackberry aromas precede intense flavours of dark red fruit and hints of vanilla. Classic Chilean Merlot.

Zinfandel, Cycles Gladiator California, USA, 2013

39.00

This wine is impeccably balanced with enough body and richness.

Valpolicella Classico DOC, Villa Crine Veneto, Italy, 2013

26.00

Classic, soft and easy drinking red, typical of this region. Deep, dark cherry, plum, with a hint of date and cinnamon.

Carmenere, Arenal, Vina Peralillo Colchagua, Chile, 2015

Jammy fruit combines with vanilla and liquorice to form a tangy medium bodied wine with moderate oak and tannins.

Côtes du Rhône, La Taladette, Gabriel Liogier Rhone Valley, France, 2013

Aromatic, fresh and lively with berry fruit, peppery nose and a hint of herb de Provence.

SPICY & WARMING

Chianti Colli Fiorentini Cortile, Guicciardini Tuscany, Italy, 2013

Berries, herbs and oak aged clove with a hint of nutmeg. Effortless balance between tannin and Italian acidity.

Shiraz Malbec, Villa Vieja Mendoza, Argentina, 2016

Modern fruity red oozing with damson, dark cherries, chocolate and liquorice.

Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine Grand Veneur, Jaume Rhone Valley, France, 2012

59.00

Robert Parker 91. Beautiful purity and elegance, with sweet black cherry, raspberry, liquorice and toasted spice. Medium to full-bodied with excellent acidity and tannin.

OAKED & INTENSE

Vacqueyras, Gabriel Liogier Rhone Valley, France, 2012

36.00

Robust, dark red fruits on the palate are introduced by primary aromas of blackberry and kirsch. Well balanced with a deep flavour that carries through to a long finish.

Barolo, Azienda Cagliero Piedmont, Italy, 2009

52.00

A stunning, classically crafted Barolo with complex fragrance of violets, subtle truffle and intense red fruit, as well as further hints of rose and leather.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Wynns Black Label Coonawarra, Australia, 2007

59.00

A full bodied purple-red, deep and lushly fruited wine. Nutty and vanillin oak-dominant.

Blend, Calicanto, Vina El Principal Maipo Valley, Chile, 2013

37.00

Cab Sav, Carmenere, Syrah, Cab Franc, Petit Verdot

Black fruit and chocolate on the nose with medium-bodied palate. Ripe, tarry blackberry and crisp tannins come to the fore.
