# 1. Boar's Kloof Chenin Blanc, Riebeck Valley

Packed with up front tropical fruit. The nose has an abundance of guava and gooseberries. The palate follows through with fruit flavours, balanced by a crisp acid to ensure a fresh and fruity style of wine. 2014 13% South Africa

# 2. Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc

Straw colour with green overtones. Intense nose of pineapples combined with flower aromas. 2013 13% Chile 250ml £5 1/4 175 ml £4 ½ btl £15

# 3. Bushranger Chardonnay

# 25. Prosecco lunette Spumante 20cl

# 29. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut
