Easily the equivalent of a delicious light-to medium-bodied Bourgogne Rouge, it offers ripe and succulent cherry, rhubarb and sweet strawberry fruit laced with cinnamon.	£29.50
Gamay de Touraine, Domaine de la Rochette, Loire, 2016 Light bodied red with juicy summer red fruit flavours, light tannins, very easy.	£29.50
Pinot Noir Little Beauty, Waihopai Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2015 Elegant and graceful, with pretty dried lavender, earl grey tea and vibrant white pepper aromatics that give way to plush plum and raspberry flavours.	£42.00

Lagoalva Quinto, Dao, Portugal, 2015 A blend of Touriga Nacional and Castelao, a ripe, juicy red that is well-rounded.	£29.00

Côtes du Rhône, "Samorens" Domaine Ferraton, France, 2015 Medium bodied and spicy with appealing notes of red fruit and cinnamon. Ideal match to Mediterranean summer dishes.	£29.00
Shiraz Grenache Hancock and Hancock, Mc Laren Vale, Australia, 2014 Classic but well made Mc Laren Rhône blend, jammy but fresh, bursting with dark plum and cherry flavours, lovely hints of liquorice and spice on the finish.	£39.50
Organic Châteauneuf du Pape Les Granieres de la Nerthe, Rhône, 2013 One of the most iconic estates in the appellation, oozes of class, structure and depth. We can find little red fruit and black fruit notes and also touches of black pepper. The palate is frank and elegant. The finish is long.	£56.00
