DRY, HERBACEOUS OR AROMATIC

7. Abadia Mercier 'A' Verdejo, Tierra de Castilla, Spain
Fruity with tropical notes, smooth and very fresh in the mouth. £18.50
8. Matra Hill Pinot Grigio, Nagyréde Estate, Hungary
Citrusy notes backed up by floral aromas and good, ultra-refreshing fruit. £20.50
9. Long Country Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile
A great everyday Sauvignon; lovely nose of flowers, herbs and citrus, crisp and fresh on the palate. £21.50
12. Running Duck Chenin/Sauvignon, South Africa
Organic and Fairtrade; delicate and nicely balanced wine with lingering flavours of lychee and green apple. £24.00
58. Mamora Vermentino, Sardinia, Italy 2016
Rich bouquet with a hint of bitter almond, mineral and zest. £29.50
56. Alois Lageder Riff Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy 2015
A soft 100% Pinot Grigio with gentle fruit flavours, including notes of green apple and citrus fruit with notes of honey; biodynamic. £29.50
69. Calusari Riesling, Cramele Recas, Romania
The palate is refreshing and dry with a well-integrated acidity with flavours of lime zest and crisp orchard fruit. £22.50
- ## BONE DRY, DELICATE
13. Picpoul de Pinet, Lumière de Garrigue, France 2017
Lively and fresh aromas with a burst of citrus fruit (grapefruit, lemon and lime), white flowers and mineral notes with a delicate touch of saltiness. Excellent with fish. £26.50
55. Mamaku Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2016
This bright, refreshing Kūwi wine has aromas and flavours of apples, pears and gooseberries. £28.00
22. Petit Chablis, Alain Geoffroy, France
Tight, ultra clean steely fruit with wet stone mineral and lemon notes. £35.00
23. Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Cherrier, Loire, France 2016
Traditionally made Sancerre at its best; highly mineral fruit and flavours of gooseberry and wet grass. £36.00

JUICY, FRUIT DRIVEN, UN-OAKED

10. Flying Solo Grenache Blanc/Viognier, Pays d'Oc France
Lots of juicy citrus and tropical fruits; the palate is crisp and refreshing with a good finish. £23.50
11. One Chain Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, Australia
Sourced from cooler climate vineyards to give a delicious, tangy wine with lots of tropical fruit and melon on the palate. £22.50
19. Mâcon Villages, La Crochette, Loran & Fils, Burgundy, France 2015
Classic southern white Burgundy with no oakings; fresh and fruity with good depth of flavour and clean refreshing fruit. £33.00
59. A to Z Pinot Gris, Oregon, USA 2015
Powerful aromatics are redolent of acacia flowers and tropical fruits; the palate has lychee, honeysuckle, nectarines and pineapple. £39.00

FULL FLAVOURED OR OAKED

57. Stellenrust Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2017
Soft vanilla oak notes on the nose, alongside tropical fruits with a mineral palate of grapefruit and pear drops. £28.50
15. Albariño Reveleste, Rias Baixas, Spain 2016
Aromas of ripe citrus fruit leading to a fresh, crisp palate of lemon zest, fresh lime, stone fruits and notes of flint soil. £29.50
68. Alasia Gavi del Comune di Gavi, Piedmont, Italy 2016
A fresh yet complex Gavi, with aromas of citrus and green apple; then a palate with more apple, stone fruits and hints of lemon. £32.50
25. Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine Ferret, Burgundy, France 2015
Powerful and aromatic, intense nose of citrus, exotic fruits, honey vanilla and toast lead to a palate of rich and bold honey, acacia and spice. £55.00

RED WINES

LIGHT, DELICATE

62. Finca Valero Tempranillo Garnacha, Aragon, Spain *Bottle*
An easy-going red boasts dark berry fruits with a hint of pepper on the finish.

28. Les Vignerons Grenache/Pinot Noir, France
Ripe cherry fruit and a touch of spice fill this delicious fruit filled wine.

64. Les Roches Beaujolais, France 2016
Fresh and crunchy redcurrant fruit with a blackberry core. Aromatic and floral on the nose.

38. Taringi Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand 2013
Rich on the nose with subtle hints of raspberries and cherries, smooth, soft and mellow on the palate with Autumn fruit flavours.

JUICY, MEDIUM BODIED

29. Long Country Merlot, Central Valley, Chile
Ripe red fruits give way to some plum and prune flavours. Soft, supple and very drinkable indeed.

63. Fico Grande Sangiovese Poderi dal Nespole, Emilia-Romagna, Italy
A soft and supple red wine carrying lovely red fruit characteristics and hints of spice and black pepper.

31. Navajas Rioja Tinto, Navarrete, Spain
This is Rioja at its precocious youthful best, with intense raspberry and black cherry fruit overlaid with a flourish of vanilla and coconut.

35. Château de Bon Ami, Bordeaux, France 2014
A forward nose of red berries, cherry and redcurrants, a smooth, well-balanced palate with darker fruit characters and subtle smokiness.

SPICY, PEPPERY, WARMING

33. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Villa Enzo, Italy *Bottle*
Cherry and leather hints on the nose followed by a satisfying palate rich with juicy fruit and very approachable, soft tannins.

36. Scotto Old Vine Zinfandel, Lodi, California 2013
A nose of deep dark fruits and bitter chocolate leads to a full palate of spices and toffee. Smooth tannins and clean acidity gives a very pleasing finish.

65. Chateau Maris, Syrah Grenache, Minervois, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 2016
Organic and biodynamic. Medium-bodied and supple palate with notes of ripe red fruit. Sunday Roast has found a friend.

41. Battle of Bosworth, Puritan Shiraz, Australia 2016
Organically grown. Floral, meaty, crushed black and blue fruit, raspberry jam and pepper. Ripe and thick with silky tannin, lashings of bouncy mixed berry fruit.

43. Vacqueyras, Beaumirail, La Cave de Gigondas, Rhône, France 2014
Soft white pepper Grenache nose with appealing roasted meat and red berry fruit characteristics. This is a superb Rhône wine and shows that Vacqueyras is more than just the little brother of Chateauneuf.

- ## INTENSE, CONCENTRATED
32. Los Haroldos Malbec, Uco Valley, Argentina
Soft and elegant with smooth tannins supporting raspberry, plum and cassis flavours alongside a healthy dose of aromatic wood and spice.

37. Caliterra Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Colchagua Valley, Chile
Tremendous aromatic intensity, with aromas of berries and violets and notes of coffee and tobacco. Voluptuous and big bodied palate, with fresh fruit and vibrant acidity.

66. Catena Appellation Vista Flores Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 2015
An outstanding quality Malbec showing plums, dark chocolate and blackberries with some spice and pepper as well.

67. Truchard Pinot Noir, California, USA 2013
Rich aromas of ripe plum, rhubarb, and wild strawberry. The mouth is silky, with bright flavours of pie cherries, cranberry, and sweet vanilla. Firm acidity and delicate tannins focus the palate and provide a lingering finish of spice and red fruit.

<i>Light and sweet with toasted nuts, figs and plums. The palate is creamy and has lots of chocolate, red berries and nuts.</i> | £5.50 |
