Louis Latour Fixin Pinot Noir, 2019, Burgundy, France With its profound ruby colour, the Fixin displays roasted notes and undergrowth aromas. Fresh on the palate, its unveils black cherry and liquorice aromas with hints of grilled notes. Silky tannins.	
Sartori, Amarone Della Valpolicella, Di Verona 2012, Italy Ruby in color, ripe fruit aromas, with notes of blackcurrant, raspberry and dried herbs; full bodied on the palate with rich fruit flavours, bright acidity & a lingering finish.	50
Pyramid Valley Appellation Collection, Pinot Noir, 2018, New Zealand Bright appearance with a ruby red hue. Floral nose with raspberry and cherry aromas, with an abundance of savoury/earthy complexity. The palate is vibrant with tension and length, showing a nice mixture of bright fruit/herbal elements and a savoury structure that North Canterbury is renowned for.	58

Bella Modella Prosecco, Italy A lively crisp Prosecco with a delicate lemony character & an aromatic, dry, refreshing finish.	29
Miss Molly, Petit Rose, South Africa Notes of pomegranate, strawberry and orange peel.	35
Gosset, Grand Blanc de Blanc Brut Champagne, France This cuvée is a pale golden colour. The nose reveals aromas of flowers, white fruits, apricots, Mirabelle plum and very light notes of lemon, citrus fruits, quince jelly and honey. On the palate, white flowers mingle with a hint of toastiness.	75
Gosset, Grand Rose Brut Champagne, France This Cwée has a soft and flowing hue of salmon pink with a few ruby-cherry reflections. The nose is clearly marked by the strawberries both the fresh fruit and as jam. Wild red cherry, redcurrant and with a hint of grapefruit dominate the palate. The mouth is well structured with a constant tension between freshness and a fruity roundness.	75
Ruinart Rose, Brut Champagne, France Intence, fruity, complex aromas of freshly picked berries, fresh mint and pink grapefruit. Silky and delicately fleshy, Ruinart Rosé Champagne offers a subtle aromatic bouquet with a pleasant freshness and gourmet roundness that explodes in a creamy ample mouth.	95
Ruinart Blanc de Blanc Champagne, France Vibrant and luminous in colour, the Blanc de Blancs is a beautiful, pale but golden tone of yellow with gentle green reflection. The persistent release of bubbles allows for an active effervescent quality. At first, the Blanc de Blancs is very intense on the nose, offering fresh and citrussy fruit notes; this is followed by a refined floral nose with notes of white flowers and fruits (white peaches, pineapple).	100

Saumaize-Michelin, Puoilly-Fuisse 2017 Succulent, ripe nose of creamy vanilla and pineapples. Rounded and generous palate, ripe grapefruits and lemon rind. A use of oak brings depth, texture and nutty characters with a soft finish.	Bottle 60
Meursault Château de Blagny, Louis Latour Côte de Beaune, 2017 Overlooking the villages of Puligny and Meursault, Chateau de Blagny vines are owned exclusively by Maison Louis Latour and it's considered to be one of the most important domaines in the commune. Pale yellow in colour, this wine has an intense aromas of stone fruit – peach and exotic fruits. It has a wonderful, textural mouthfeel, good weight and richness with attractive, fleshy fruit flavours.	75
Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, Louis Latour, Côte de Beaune, 2014 Top flight white Burgundy at its best, it is difficult to find chardonnay of this quality anywhere in the worldthe Latour family have the largest acreage in this very sought after but tiny appellation located on the Corton hillside. Superb pale yellow colour it shows an intense and complex nose of toasted almond with slightly smoked notes. The palate is very generous and forthright with good minerality, wonderful length	180

Segla, Margaux, 2014 This is the second wine of Chateau Rauzan Segla which is located a stones throw away from the village of Margaux in Bordeaux and one of the top 2 nd wines of the vintage, not to be overlooked. Fresh and soft with ample amount of sweet, dark fruit and fine polished tannins. It's in perfect balance with an open forward character.	55
Brunello di Montalcino, Castello Banfi, 2013 A "classic" of their production, this wine is obtained with clones of Sangiovese selected after 20 years of research on this unique grape and is aged in French oak barrels. Ruby red with nice concentration, prunes, cherries & liquorice	60
Chateau Gloria, Saint Julien, 2014 Chateau Gloria is an unclassified property in the appellation of Saint Julien in Bordeaux that punches way above its weight often producing wines of equal quality to some of the more prestigious classed growths. Classic aromas of blackberry, cedarwood and tobacco this is rich and powerful. Medium to full weight on the palate with a fine tannin structure and a fresh, seamless finish.	60
Chateau Cantermerle, Haut-Medoc, 2009 Chateau Cantermerle is an historical estate within the Haut-Medoc in Bordeaux and is designated a Fifth Growth in the 1855 classification and one of the elite properties in the region. Spicy, plummy nose with hints of cigar box, ripe fruit and richly textured on the palate with integrated tannins, stylish and long.	85
Chateau Batailley, Pauillac, 2010 Classified Fifth Growth situated in the Pauillac appellation, owned by the Castéja family it is one of the best known and oldest estates within the Medoc. There is no doubt that this property made one of it's best vintages ever in 2010. Classic well built cabernet based claret with notes of cassis and cedar, medium bodied, lovely fruit ripeness and well knit, fine tannins, very persistent finish.	95
