2 Mercier Brut NV The impression of sweetness on the finish of this champagne appeals to those who do not like their Champagne too dry. It's release after two years of maturity also helps the enjoyment of a softer glass of bubbles.	7.5	39
3 Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial, France Classically, a third each of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay and matured for at least three years in bottle, which helps give the wine its typical biscuity flavour.	9.5	55
4 Galanti Pinot Grigio Spumante Rosé, Italy Light and fresh rosé with ripe red summer fruit flavours made from the Pinot Grigio variety grown in northern Italy.		28
5 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.		57
6 Dom Pérignon Brut 2003, Champagne Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.		135

25 Malbec, Rare Vineyards, Pays d'Oc, France From the original home of Malbec - South-West France. Lighter than its Argentinian counterpart, but equally quaffable; black fruits and delicate spice will not fail to impress.	5.25	7.5	22
26 Pinot Noir, Dashwood, Marlborough, New Zealand Crunchy, voluptuous black and red cherry fruit, wrapped in vanilla and spice. A wine with smooth tannins, a refreshing cranberry acidity and rich velvety finish.	6	8.5	25

31 Veramonte Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Maipo Valley, Chile Rich blackcurrants with a dash of spice. Very smooth and pronounced with a super balance and long lingering finish.			24
32 Passori Rosso, Veneto, Italy Rich, smooth red wine, showing plum and dried fruit followed by notes of spice and vanilla.			30
33 Don Jacobo Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Corral, Spain Traditional Rioja with a stylish, silky balance of ripe cherry flavours and generous vanilla-oak character for a mature style.			35
34 Gamay-Pinot Noir Coteaux Bourguignons Rouge, Louis Jadot This Gamey-Pinot Noir shows fresh, light, red and black summer fruits with an elegant soft finish.			35
35 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Cornalines Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.			40
36 Château des Bardes, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, France The wine has rich, fruit aromas; juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla-toastiness from time spent in oak.			40
