COGNAC

Just north of Bordeaux lies the region of Cognac. Here the vineyards are planted with Ugni Blanc, Folle Blanche and small amounts of Colombard, all known for producing sharp acidic wines. At the forefront of the industry in Cognac is the house of Hennessy, founded in 1765 by Richard Hennessy. At the heart of Hennessy lies the Filloux family who over seven generations have provided the firm with their master blenders. Drawing from their extensive supply of eaux-de-vies spread over several cellars or "Paradis", Hennessy is able to provide an unrivalled portfolio of exceptional cognac. The Paradis Impérial is an historical blend created for the Russian Imperial Court to celebrate the 42nd birthday of Tsar Alexander I. Composed of a selection of rare eaux-de-vies ranging from 40 years old up to 150 years old, this is an exclusive experience of which only 12 bottles are available in the UK.
