## SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

GLASS BOTTLE

### PROSECCO DOC SPUMANTE, ITALY – 11%

6.75 27.50

Pale light yellow colour, with fine perlage. Delicately fruity with hints of ripe pears, flowers & some mineral notes on the nose. This is a well-balanced sparkling wine with a light body, but quite a long finish.

### FORGET BRIMONT BRUT PREMIER CRU BRUT CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE – 12%

46

This full, round wine melds rich pear & tangerine flavours with fine acidity. It's crisp, fragrant & ripe, showing some signs of bottle age in its toasty character.

## WHITES

GLASS BOTTLE

### CANDIDATO VIURA, SPAIN – 11.5%

5.00 19.50

Its expressive nose exudes aromatic reminders of lemon, pineapple, grapefruit and quince with floral hints reminiscent of camomile and jasmine.

### GAYDA T'AIR D'OC SAUVIGNON BLANC, FRANCE – 12.5%

5.75 22.50

All Gayda's vineyards adhere to strict environmentally responsible vineyard management & all grapes are hand-picked. This Sauvignon has tropical fruits & melon on the nose leading to a crispy lively palate. It has good acidity & a clean finish.

### BONOTTO DELLE TEZZE PINOT GRIGIO, ITALY – 12%

5.95 23.50

From the foothills of the Alps, this Pinot Grigio has a bouquet of tropical fruits with hints of pineapple & lemon.

### CEFIRO RESERVE CHARDONNAY, CHILE – 13.5%

6.25 24.75

The wine has an intense combination of tropical fruit aromas, especially pineapple & banana. Fresh & well-balanced with soft tones of vanilla & toffee. This is a medium-bodied, intense, rich & complex Chardonnay. *(Vegan friendly)*

### PICPOUL DE PINET, FRANCE – 12.5%

6.50 25.75

The nose flaunts lemons, lime zest & gooseberry notes. The citrus carries right through onto the palate with snappy acidity & a quenching mineral finish.

### HEART OF STONE SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND – 12.5%

7.00 27.75

This is a vibrant wine with flavours of blackberry, gooseberry & passion fruit underscored by appetising, crisp acidity which produces a refreshing finish.

### FORREST ESTATE PINOT GRIS, NEW ZEALAND – 13%

30.00

An attractive nose of ripe peach, nashi pear, red apple, honey suckle and just a hint of white flowers.

### SARTARELLI VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI CLASSICO, ITALY – 13%

26.50

A well-structured wine, fresh and sapid at the same time, soft on the palate, has a good alcoholic structure and the characteristic slightly bitter almond aftertaste.

### REYNEKE SAUVIGNON BLANC, SOUTH AFRICA – 12.5%

38

On the nose, there are aromas of pink grapefruit, lime leaf & lemon zest notes with a hint of ripe gooseberries.

### PAJZOS TOKAJI FURMINT, HUNGARY – 12%

29

A Fresh Modern Dry White blend of Furmint, Harslevelu & Yellow Muscat. Spring Meadow & Mango Bouquet, Clean Dry & Well Balanced Palate.

### SANCERRE ANDRE DEZAT, FRANCE – 13%

37.50

Aromas of fresh cut grass, white flowers, citrus and exotic fruits, infused throughout with the typical Sancerre elegance and mineral character.

## ROSÉ

GLASS BOTTLE

### AMBROISIE ROSE D'ANJOU, FRANCE – 10.5%

5.75 22.75

Made with carefully picked Loire speciality Grolleau grapes from the gently rolling hills of the western Loire to make this deliciously fruity off-dry Rosé, adding a pinch of Gamay grapes to boost the fruit aromas.

### ROC DES ANGES EFFET PAPILLON ROSE, FRANCE – 12.5%

26.50

It shows hints of strawberries with an intriguing mineral undertone.

### VILLA WOLF PINOT NOIR ROSE, GERMANY – 11.5%

28.50

Intense mineral tones of smoke and crushed slate collide with fresh red cherry and raspberry flavours on the palate.

## REDS

GLASS BOTTLE

### CANDIDATO TEMPRANILLO, SPAIN – 13%

5.00 19.50

This producer is committed to sustainable viticulture with minimal use of agrochemicals & practices to reduce waste. This is a great example of Tempranillo: Spain's most popular red varietal.

### MONFIL GARNACHA, SPAIN – 13.5%

5.75 22.00

Extended softness in the mouth, cherry, blueberries and a touch of pepper. Nice and smooth, supple tannins with an excellent finish.


### GAYDA T'AIR D'OC SYRAH, FRANCE - 13.5%

5.75 23.00

Domaine Gayda is a fully organic vineyard working towards full certification. This Syrah is one of the key varietals of the Languedoc where the terroir brings out the ripe black fruit & spicy notes.

### CEFIRO RESERVE MERLOT, CHILE – 13.5%

6.00 24.00

From the excellent Casablanca estate in the valley of the same name. The climate combined with granitic soils promotes long ripening periods, giving this Merlot freshness as well as concentration of fruit. 

### ALTOSUR MALBEC, ARGENTINA – 13.5%

6.50 26.00

Grown & bottled at an elevation of 4000 feet high. This wine shows intense aromas & fruity flavours.

### RUSTENBERG SHIRAZ, SOUTH AFRICA - 14%

6.75 27

The palate is medium bodied with a fine line of acidity, crisp tannins and expressive red berry fruit mixed with spice and cloves on the finish.

### UNO PIU UNO, MICHELLE BIANCARDI, ITALY – 12.5%

29

This wine combines the best Primitivo & Nero di Troia grapes which are aged in stainless steel tanks for 6-8 months. The result is a wine that is robust and jammy, with hints of tobacco. *(Organic)*

### VINA BUJANDA CRIANZA, RIOJA, SPAIN – 13 %

7.00 27.50

Aromas of blackberry and bilberry together with spicy tones (clove and cinnamon) from the American oak in which the wine spends 12 months, imparting mild tobacco and light balsamic notes.

### CONDADO DE HAZA, TEMPRANILLO, SPAIN – 14.5%

35

Brilliant ruby. Smoky aromas of blackberry, cherry pit and game, with a subtle floral nuance in the background. In a wild, meaty style, offering sweet, focused cherry compote and bitter chocolate flavours and a touch of allspice. Finishes very long, with lingering smokiness and fine-grained tannins.

### ALEJANDRO FERNANDEZ PESQUERA CRIANZA, SPAIN, 14.5%

42

A silky, clean wine with hints of fresh varietals that reappear under the tongue after the first few seconds in the glass, intertwined with the impeccable smokiness of wood. Flavours of liquorice, blackberries and spicy linger long on the memory

### FORREST ESTATE PINOT NOIR, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND – 13.5%

Dr John Forrest is committed to sustainable viticulture on his Marlborough family estate. This is an excellent example of New Zealand Pinot Noir – medium bodied, silky & beautifully balanced.
