Our Champagnes are listed from lightest to richest in style. The light and ethereal Pol Roger made from equal parts of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier contrasts with Krug's majestic barrel fermented and Pinot Noir dominated offering.

One of the stars of the list is Bruno Paillard, the dynamo behind one of the region's youngest Champagne Houses. Grapes are sourced from selected high-quality Crus in the Champagne region. Only the first pressing of the grapes is used, (hence 'Premiere Cuvee') and this is blended with Reserve wines to create the final cuvee.

When a white wine is described as crisp or fresh, it indicates the wine has a lively, attractive, acidity, rather as you would expect from a nice juicy apple.

Even in these dry wines fruit character will shine through, whether the pear fruitiness of the Lageder Pinot Bianco or the slight gooseberry undertones of the Pouilly Fume. Often it is only through careful matching with the right food that these flavours become apparent. Drunk with fish, the acidity of the wine brings out the flavour of the food, while the saltiness of the fish in turn emphasises the fruitiness of the wine.

Spy Valley is in the heart of Marlborough, New Zealand's premium region for the variety, and offers intense gooseberry, passion fruit and nettly aromas. Drink it with seafood and Pacific Rim influenced food.

As a rule of thumb, those who believe in decanting would give several hours airing to a young wine, one to two hours to a wine that had reached its normal expected maturity and treat an old wine as an elderly relative, kept out of draughts.

Not well received by those used to fine French Clarets, in the early 18th century they hit upon the idea of stopping the fermentation by adding brandy while the wine was still sweet and fruity and hence making port the most popular wine in Britain from the 18th to early 20th century.
