Le Tuffeau Sauvignon Blanc 2013 (France)	£5.20	£7.50	£21.00
Le Tuffeau is a super-fresh, zippy Sauvignon with vibrant, ripe citrus-fruit aromas. The grapes are sourced from vineyards near the beautiful town of Carcassonne.			
Rick Stein Spanish White 2014 Castilla y León (Spain)	£5.80	£8.40	£23.50
After a number of seafood delights while filming in Galicia and drinking cold Castilla y León from white china cups, I had to find a really well made one for us. It's charmingly fresh and fragrant. Made with Virura and Verdejo grapes, it's a wine to celebrate my Spanish book and TV series.			
Pinot Grigio Villa Fiore 2014 (Venezia Giulia, Italy)	£6.30	£8.90	£25.00
Many Pinot Grigios that you come across these days are weak and dull with none of the smell and flavour of the grape. This shows exactly how Pinot Grigio should taste, soft but crisp acidity and a faintly spicy element which marks the fruit of this wine.

Ripe varietal fruit consisting of white peach, melon and punchy citrus giving a crisp freshness and balance.			
Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine Sur Lie Domaine Gadais Pere et Fils 2014 (Loire France)	£7.00	£10.00	£28.00
Really first class Muscadet, perfect with oysters... you don't believe it? Drinking is believing!			
Aves del Sur Gewurztraminer 2015 (Chile)	£7.50	£10.70	£29.95

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Fascinating white wine made from the characterful Albarino grape. We think this is one of the best we have tasted - delicious.

Sancerre 2013 La Mercy-Dieu Domaine Bailly-Reverdy (France)			£44.00
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Viña Gravonia 2004 Bodegas R.Lo'pez de Heredia, Rioja (Spain)			£46.00
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Lovely old style Rioja, unashamedly touched with oak & full bodied fruit, but with a good acidic edge.

Meursault Les Meix Chavaux 2012 Château Génot-Boulangier (France)			£90.00
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A wine of great minerality, length and finesse. Full and concentrated, but not overtly flabby. Tropical and citrus fruit flavours with hints of brioche and vanilla.

RED WINE

Valle Hermoso Merlot 2013 (Central Valley, Chile)	£5.20	£7.50	£21.00
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A lighter medium weight style of Merlot with lush plummy fruit and rounded tannins.

Son Excellence Syrah	£5.50	£7.80	£22.00
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Rich and smooth and concentrated with mulberries, cassis and red cherries, with soft and silky tannins.

Passo del Tempio Syrah 2014 (Sicily)	£5.50	£7.80	£22.00
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This Syrah is from Western Sicily and is full of ripe black fruits with a subtle creamy long finish.

Rick Stein Spanish Red Garnacha 2014 (Spain)	£6.00	£8.60	£24.00
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Rick and his son Charlie worked together to select this wine to match with the flavours he encountered on his journey through Spain. A delicious juicy and ripe red.

Kaiken Malbec Reserve 2013 (Argentina)	£7.00	£10.00	£28.00
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This vineyard sits at 950ft in Mendoza. Kaiken Reserve is deep violet in colour with rich layers of chocolate and a little spice too - stunning Malbec.

Cycles Gladiator Pinot Noir 2013 (California)	£8.00	£11.40	£31.95
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California's Central Coast is great for producing Pinot Noir – really elegant with rich scented fruit – great with fish.

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We are much enthused by this Cinsault, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah blend from the Bekaa valley in Lebanon. Elegant is the word, powerful and elegant.

Chateau Terrey-Gros-Cailloux 2006			£48.50
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Lovely classic Saint-Julien. Earthy and cedary with lovely fruit, hint of green tea, medium weight, relatively soft with gentle but firm tannins, good length.
