Bottle

1. **Ladera Verde Sauvignon, Valle Central (Chile)** **£14.50**  
*Crisp and fresh with limey fruit, a hint of herbs and a twist of melon. Great with seafood.*  
**Per 125ml £2.60 Per 175ml £3.85 Per 250ml £5.20**
2. **Amanti del Vino, Pinot Grigio, Colline Pavesesi IGT (Italy)** **£14.50**  
*This Pinot Grigio is crisp, refreshing and unoaked. Lovely on its own or with a summery salad.*  
**Per 125ml £2.60 Per 175ml £3.85 Per 250ml £5.20**
3. **Pato Torrente Chardonnay, Valle Central (Chile)** **£14.95**  
*There is a mouth-watering combination of ripe, lemony citrus fruit and balancing acidity. Good with roast pork, mussels & lightly spiced seafood.*

4. **La Petite Vigne Viognier, IGP d'Oc (France)** **£15.50**  
*Wonderfully aromatic with delicious fruit and excellent length.*
5. **Sunnycliff Chardonnay, Victoria (Australia)** **£16.50**  
*This wine has sheer drinkability, everything is well balanced so one glass is not enough!*
6. **Green Drake Chenin/Sauvignon, Stellar Organics, Western Cape (South Africa)** **£16.95**  
*Fresh, full and flavoursome, this ethically traded and organic wine combines peachy Chenin fruit with grassy Sauvignon nuances.*
7. **Pask Omahu Road Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay (New Zealand)** **£18.95**  
*A typical New Zealand Sauvignon with opulent, ripe, tropical fruit and all the classic Sauvignon character one could wish for.*
8. **CVNE Blanco Barrel Fermented, Rioja (Spain)** **£20.00**  
*Fruit and oak are well balanced in this fresh, dry white.*
9. **Chablis, Les Valery (France)** **£27.00**  
*This has green-tinged hues, an elegant slightly steely quality with aromas and flavours of freshly baked brioche.*
10. **Sancerre, André Dezat et Fils (France)** **£27.00**  
*Dry and fruity with a wonderfully delicate bouquet and great length.*

## Red Wines

11. **Ladera Verde Merlot, Valle Central (Chile)** **£14.50**  
*This has lovely plummy Merlot fruit with a ripeness that is so typical of Chile. Delicious with pasta, ham and cheese.*

12. **Wide River Shiraz, Robertson (South Africa)** **£14.50**  
*Easy going, soft red with plenty of spicy, peppery fruit, this has good hedgerow berry flavours and power. Goes well with grilled meat and game.*

13. **Rioja Vega Tempranillo (Spain)** **£14.95**  
*A soft, fruity wine with plum and blackcurrant flavours, vibrant and juicy. Great with lamb dishes.*

14. **Amanti del Vino Sangiovese, Rubicone IGT (Italy)** **£14.95**  
*This has juicy, soft fruit with hints of black cherries and plums. Attractive, easy going wine from Emilia-Romagna.*
15. **Rayun Carmenère, Valle Central (Chile)** **£15.50**  
*Late picking and slightly cooler slopes are key, and the result is a rich, curranty wine with depth and length.*
16. **Tanners Claret, Bordeaux (France)** **£16.50**  
*This has been made even more attractive by the addition of some extra old-vine Merlot to give it a bit more of the succulence and juiciness for which it is renowned, while still retaining its classic balance and style.*
17. **Sunnycliff Cabernet Sauvignon, South Eastern Australia (Australia)** **£16.50**  
*A softer style of Cabernet that boasts ripe juicy fruit flavours and bags of Aussie sunshine.*
18. **Rioja Vega, Crianza Tinto (Spain)** **£18.50**  
*This is a smooth, soft, richly-fruited red, has spice and vanilla from 12 months in American oak.*
19. **Kate Radburn Pinot Noir, Marlborough (New Zealand)** **£23.50**  
*A succulent fruit filled Pinot with both red and black fruit flavours. It has good body and well balanced acidity.*

## Rosé Wines

20. **Pinot Grigio Rosé, Provincia di Pavia IGT, Ca' Solare (Italy)** **£14.50**  
*A copper pink rosé from Northern Italy's Pavia region with gently fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry.*

25. **Prosecco, Vetricano (Italy)** **£16.50**  
*An attractive biscuity nose leads onto a bright fruity palate with hints of pears and melon. An excellent aperitif on its own or with peach juice as a Bellini.*
26. **Tanners Brut Extra Réserve Champagne, (France)** **£35.00**
