Viognier Delas Freres 2016, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France			£30
<i>Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.</i>			
Gavi di Gavi La Contessa 2016, Piedmont, Italy			£35
<i>Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry.</i>			

Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek 2016 , Marlborough, New Zealand £36

This is an absolute classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant gooseberry, passionfruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness. Impressive weight of flavour on the palate with richness, texture and a long finish.

Firestone Riesling, Central Coast 2013, California, United States £36

Wonderfully zesty and aromatic, with green apple, lemon, lime and jasmine aromas. The palate is light-bodied yet full of flavour, with a tingling balance of ripe fruit and fresh acidity.

Sancerre Domaine Cherrier 2015, Loire Valley, France £38

Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.

Organic Chablis , Domaine Brocard 2015, Burgundy, France £40

Fresh nose with light fruity aromas and elegant minerality on the palate; compared to Brocard's regular Chablis, this organic version has an extra degree of vividness and savoury complexity.

Clos des Lunes Lune Blanche, Bordeaux Blanc 2014, Bordeaux, France £48

This classic Sémillon-Sauvignon blend has vibrant aromas of white peach, lychee and acacia flowers. Ripe, concentrated fruit on the palate is balanced by a citrus freshness, leading to a long, generous finish.

Meursault Vieilles Vignes 2014, Burgundy, France £65

A classic, taut Meursault offering aromas of roasted almonds, white flowers and mineral notes. The fresh, pure structure conceals impressive weight and concentration.

Rosé

Stone Cellars Zinfandel Rosé 2016, California, United States **175ml 250ml Bottle**

Fruity aromas and flavours of ripe strawberries and some spicy clove/nutmeg notes. Soft, well-rounded palate, in a medium style.

Côtes de Provence Rosé 2016, France £6.9 £9.2 £27

A pale salmon hue with notes of white peaches and lychees on the nose. Fresh and lively on the palate, fairly light in body, with a refreshing dry finish.

Foxwood Pepper Patch Syrah 2015, Languedoc-Roussillon, France	£6	£8.1	£24
<i>This wine has expressive Syrah characters of blackberry, woodsmoke and pepper. Medium-full in body, with a herbal lift to the juicy fruit on the palate, this wine is the essence of the South.</i>			
Merlot, d'Alamel 2014, Chile	£6.95	£9	£27
<i>A round, voluptuous Merlot with plum and cherry aromas, a juicy feel in the mouth and a long, smooth finish. The oak adds a touch of spicy complexity.</i>			
Norton Porteno Malbec 2017, Mendoza, Argentina	£6.5	£8.75	£26
<i>This luscious Malbec has aromas of violets, strawberries and black cherries, leading to a smooth, full-bodied palate with a hint of peppery spice.</i>			
Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2015, Abruzzi, Italy	£6.75	£9	£28
<i>A concentrated, juicy Montepulciano with earthy cherry and berry flavours, a round yet spicy palate, and a smooth, fruity finish.</i>			
Zero-G Zweigelt 2016, Wagram, Austria			£29
<i>Light in body yet intensely flavoured, this Zweigelt offers a great blend of spice and berry fruit. The cherry succulence on the palate is offset by a lick of black pepper, while the texture is gentle yet refreshing.</i>			
Cloof Pinotage 2015, Darling, South Africa			£29
<i>The bold, concentrated flavours of this wine are directly attributable to the tiny yield of mature bush vines growing under extreme conditions. Richly textured with notes of smoke, blackberry, plum with some spiciness and elegant oaky notes.</i>			
Featherdrop Pinot Noir 2017, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand, 100% Pinot Noir			£32
<i>This charming wine offers aromas of blackberry, raspberry, smoky oak and floral notes. Sweet ripe cherry and raspberry flavours complement the fine structure and subtle spicy oak. The finish is long and soft, with elegant raspberry fruit.</i>			
Guenoc California Petite Sirah 2015, California, United States			£33
<i>Gutsy, appetising wine with blueberry, rhubarb and vanilla on the nose. The palate is smooth and fruit-driven, but still with the robustness to partner hearty dishes.</i>			
Casa Valduga Raizes Cabernet Franc 2013, Brazil			£30
<i>A fascinating example of Cabernet Franc showing red fruits, strawberry and cherries well matched with spices; soft yet refreshing on the palate.</i>			
Fleurie Clos des Quatre Vents 2015, Burgundy, France			£36
<i>Full-bodied for Fleurie, with plenty of oomph to match the trademark floral character, and complex nuances, both savoury and fruity, on the palate.</i>			

Villa Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva 2013, Tuscany, Italy £43

This is a rich, modern Chianti that marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with well-judged smoky oak notes. The opulence on the palate is tempered by savoury notes of clove and a firm structure supporting the plump fruit.

Chateau Montaguillon, Montagne St Emilion, Bordeaux 2012 £46

A Beautiful Medium to Full bodied Bordeaux, Soft Blackberry and cedar notes on the nose – plump ripe berry on the palet holding good acidity and very long dry finish – stunning

Privada (Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot) 2014, Argentina £51

Excellent aromatic complexity with notes of ripe fruit, spices, and hints of smoke and coffee. Rich and generous on the palate with superb concentration.

Finca Nueva Rioja Gran Reserva 2004, Rioja, Spain £63

This Rioja Reserva offers a great combination of ripe fruit – plum, cherry, blackcurrant – and mature savoury notes of cedar and tobacco. Fresh, polished and harmonious, it is a charming and very complete Reserva.
