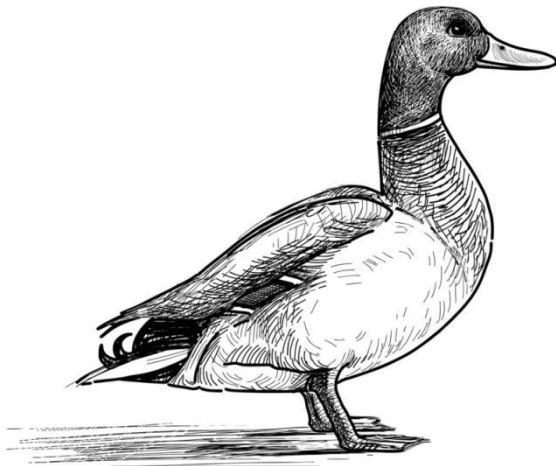

One of France's great white wines, delicate colour, candied apples, hint of oak.

26. Pouilly-Fumé Les Berthiers, J. C. Dagueneau, Loire Valley, France 2014

Refined, citrusy Sauvignon, with a lively medium-bodied palate, some flinty minerality, and a dry, elegant finish.

27. Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc, Domaine Beaudrenard, Rhône Valley, France, 2013

A lovely nose of apricots and peach, good acidity and wonderful balance.

| <i>Medium to full-bodied, the bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit is followed by a savoury earthy note. The tannins are silky and well-rounded with a fresh finish.</i> | | | |

FROM THE CELLAR

55. Gevrey-Chambertin Les Evocelles, Henri de Villamont, Burgundy, France 2013

An elegant style of Gevrey from a well-situated single vineyard, offering a beguiling blend of red and black berry fruit, a juicy texture, and a hint of earthy complexity.

56. Tignanello, Familia Antinori, Tuscany IGT, Italy 2006

This super Tuscan offers a combination of ripe, dark fruit and an underlying freshness, plum and cherries mingle with mint and liquorice - superb.

57. Château Langoa Barton, St. Julien, Bordeaux, France 2009

Medium to full bodied, nose of red berries and cranberries, hints of cedar. Long and elegant finish.

58. Chorey-Lès-Beaune, Domaine Tolleot-Beaut, Burgundy, France 2013

Rich yet soft velvety wine made from Pinot Noir, straw-berry-scented and subtle tannins, Tolleot-Beaut is a true master of the Côtes de Beaune region.

59. Château Cissac, Haut Médoc, Bordeaux, France 2014

This wine shows the fresh, focused character of the 2010 vintage, with powerful currant fruit aromas.
